Maa Maha Gauri

Om Maha Gauri Daivya Namah

It is auspicious to worship Maha Gauri on Ashtami Tithi of Navratra. On this day devotee meditates upon all chakras from Mooladhar to Sahasrnaar. It helps in awakening of Kundalini. Worship on this day endows courage and valor to devotee. Goddess Maa Gauri possesses four arms. In one hand she carries trident of Lord Shiva, second hand is resting on Abhaya Mudra, Third hand carries tabor (damroo), fourth hand is also resting on mudra. Maa is ascended on bull. Maa Parvati had observed penance to get married to Lord Shiva. BY worshipping Maa Gauri devotee gets married to partner of own choice. Maa Gauri gets easily pleased by young daughters. One whose marriage is getting delayed she should worship Maa Gauri.

The Procedure to Worship:

Foremost place one wooden plank at place of worship. Spread white cloth on it. On top of that establish image of Maha Gauri. Next to it place Maha Gauri Yantra. Take white flowers in hand and meditate on magnificent Maa Gauri.

After meditation offer white flowers to lotus feet of Maa Gauri. Worship Maa Gauri with Panchopchar and Shodopchar. Offer sweets prepared from milk to Maa Gauri as prasaad. Thereafter chant 21 rosaries of mantra Om Aing Hring Kling Chamundayae Vichchayae and Om Maha Gauri Devayae Namah! Chant Aarti and devotional songs. This will help in fulfilling all goals.

Every day after bath offer Coconut fruit to Maa Bhagwati. Later break the fruit into small pieces and distribute among all close ones. It will take away all sorrows from life of devotee.
